



MEN'S HOCKEY

The Ohio State men's hockey team ended the 2006-07 season 15-17-5 overall and finished seventh in the Central Collegiate Hockey Association with a 12-12-4 record.

A highlight of the squad's year was winning the 2006 Ohio Hockey Classic, defeating then-No. 4 Miami, 5-3, in the championship game Dec. 30 at Nationwide Arena. It was the first OHC title for Ohio State in the three-year history of the tournament. All five OSU goals against the RedHawks were scored by seniors as seven of eight members of the class had at least one point in the game, led by forwards Kenny Bernard and Mathieu Beaudoin who each tallied a goal and an assist. The Buckeyes topped Minnesota Duluth of the WCHA, 4-1, in their first round game Dec. 29. Senior captain Sean Collins was named MVP of the 2006 Ohio Hockey Classic and joined teammates Tom Fritsche, Tommy Goebel and Joseph Palmer on the All-Tournament team.

Fritsche was the recipient of the CCHA's Terry Flanagan Memorial Award, given annually to an upperclassman that has overcome some type of personal adversity and is active on the university campus and surrounding community. Fritsche, the Buckeyes' leading scorer his first two seasons with the squad and a second-round draft pick of the Colorado Avalanche, returned to the lineup Dec. 29 after suffering from severe ulcerative colitis, a chronic intestinal disorder that forced him to miss the first half of the 2006-07 season.

Collins was voted the Bobby Brown Most Valuable Player by his teammates after leading the squad with a career-best 28 points en route to a spot on the All-CCHA Second Team. He was the first true blueliner to lead the Buckeyes in scoring since 1970.

In the first intermission of the Nov. 4 game against Notre Dame, the Ohio State men's hockey team retired its first jersey in program history in Paul Pooley's No. 22 sweater. Pooley, a former Buckeye All-American who played for the Scarlet and Gray 1981-84, is the team's all-time leading scorer with 270 points as well as the record-holder for career goals and assists and single-season points and assists. He was named the Bauer National Player of the Year in 1981 and is the only Buckeye to be named CCHA Player of the Year.
