

## **POSTGAME NOTES**

Iowa 72 (13-4, 3-3 B1G), No. 16 Ohio State 62 (12-4, 2-3 B1G)

Jan. 12, 2019

Carver-Hawkeye Arena – Iowa City, Iowa

## **GAME/SERIES**

- Ohio State falls to 75-78 all-time against Iowa and 49-26 in Iowa City.
- The Buckeyes are 24-13 against the Hawkeyes when ranked in the *Associated Press* Top-25.

## **TEAM**

- When leading at the half, Ohio State falls to 8-3 on the season.
- The Buckeye bench scored 32 points in the contest. This is the most bench points in seven games for Ohio State and the sixth-highest mark of the season in this category for the team.
- Ohio State outshot Iowa from 3-point range, shooting 40% from beyond the arc (10-25) while the Hawkeyes shot 25% (4-16).
- Both the Buckeyes and the Hawkeyes grabbed 37 boards in the contest. This is the first time this season that Ohio State has tied its opponent in rebounds.

## **CHRIS HOLTMANN**

- Chris Holtmann is now 2-2 all-time against the Hawkeyes as a head coach.

## **ANDRE WESSON**

- Andre Wesson led the Buckeye scoring effort with 13 points in the contest. The game marked the sixth time this season that he has scored in double figures and his second time this season earning team-high honors.
- The junior finished 2-for-3 from 3-point range and added three rebounds, one block and one assist.

## **C.J. JACKSON**

- C.J. Jackson, who scored 10 points in the contest, has scored in double figures in 10 of the last 11 games for Ohio State.
- With three made 3-pointers against Iowa, Jackson has made at least one 3-pointer in all but one game this season and in the last 11 outings.
- Jackson grabbed four boards, three assists and one steal for the Buckeyes.

## **MUSA JALLOW**

- Musa Jallow's eight points for the Buckeyes were his first points in six games. Two of his three made field goals were 3-pointers which he scored on his first two field goal attempts of the contest.
- Jallow grabbed two boards and three steals for Ohio State.

**JUSTIN AHRENS**

- Justin Ahrens scored a career-high six points in the contest. His two made field goals were 3-pointers, another career-high mark for the freshman. He added a career-high three rebounds for Ohio State.
- Ahrens played 11 minutes for the Buckeyes, tying his career-high minutes played which he last earned against South Carolina State (11/18/28).
