

POSTGAME NOTES

Ohio State 79 (19-13), Indiana 75 (17-15)

March 14, 2019

United Center – Chicago, Ill.

GAME/SERIES

- Ohio State improves to 81-105 in the all-time series with Indiana.
- Ohio State is 2-5 when playing on neutral courts against the Hoosiers.

B1G TOURNAMENT

- Ohio State is 2-2 against Indiana in the Big Ten Tournament.
- The Buckeyes are 27-14 all-time in BTT play. Ohio State has won 24 of its last 34 league tournament games.
- Ohio State is 4-1 as the No. 8 seed in the BTT and 13-6 in BTT openers.
- The Buckeyes are 12-5 in the tournament when it is held in Chicago.
- Ohio State dished out a team BTT-high 22 assists in the contest.
- With 27 wins in the BTT, the Buckeyes own the third-most wins in the tournament behind Illinois (28) and Michigan State (29). The team's .658 (27-41) win percentage in the tournament is the highest average among active members of the Big Ten Conference.

TEAM

- Ohio State improves to 15-3 when leading at the half this season.
- C.J. Jackson (17), Andre Wesson (13), Kaleb Wesson (17) and Keyshawn Woods (18) all scored in double figures for the Buckeyes.
- The Buckeyes held Indiana's leading scorer Romeo Langford to nine points in the contest. He was averaging 16.7 ppg. entering the game.
- Ohio State outscored Indiana in points off turnovers, 24-6, and outrebounded the Hoosiers, 38-33.
- The team's 22 assists are the second-most the Buckeyes have recorded this season.

CHRIS HOLTSMANN

- Chris Holtmann is 1-1 in the BTT and 24-15 in conference play as a head coach of the Buckeyes.
- Holtmann improves to 5-2 against Indiana as a head coach.

KALEB WESSON

- Kaleb Wesson notched a double-double for Ohio State (17 points, 13 rebounds). This is his fifth double-double of his career and fourth this season.
- Wesson's 13 total rebounds and 10 defensive rebounds are a career high for the sophomore.
- Wesson finished 6-for-7 from the free-throw line, dished three helpers, had three blocks and two steals.

KEYSHAWN WOODS

- In his first BTT game, Keyshawn Woods led the Buckeyes with 18 points in the contest. He has led the Buckeyes in scoring three times this season.
- Woods grabbed seven boards to tie his season best.
- Woods finished with four assists, two steals and one block.

C.J. JACKSON

- C.J. Jackson's three made 3-pointers put him at 146 makes for his career. He now ranks 10th in program history in career made 3-point field goals. He is one shy of Sean Connolly (2001-03) and Neshawn Coleman (1996-99) who are tied for eighth with 147 makes.
- Jackson's 17-point performance puts him 12 points shy of becoming the 58th player in Ohio State history to score 1,000 career points.
- Jackson grabbed five boards, dished five helpers and had three steals in the contest.
