

POSTGAME NOTES

Michigan State 77 (26-6), Ohio State 70 (19-14)

March 15, 2019

United Center – Chicago, Ill.

GAME/SERIES

- Ohio State is 57-71 in the all-time series with the Spartans.
- On neutral courts, the Buckeyes are 3-5 against Michigan State.

B1G TOURNAMENT

- Ohio State finishes 1-1 in the 2019 BTT and is 27-15 all-time in the BTT.
- The Buckeyes are 3-5 against Michigan State and 4-2 as the No. 8 seed in the tournament.
- In games where the Buckeyes are the lower seed, the team is 6-11.

TEAM

- Ohio State outscored Michigan State on the fast break, 13-10, and second-chance opportunities, 7-6.
- The Buckeyes went on a 16-2 run in the final four minutes of the game but were unable to complete the comeback against the Spartans.
- Ohio State's 12 made 3-point field goals tie the most made 3-pointers in the 2019 BTT.
- The Buckeyes finish the season 3-1 in games played at the United Center.

CHRIS HOLTMANN

- Chris Holtmann is 1-3 against Michigan State as head coach of the Buckeyes.
- Holtmann is now 1-2 in the BTT.

KEYSHAWN WOODS

- For the second consecutive game and his second BTT game of his career, Keyshawn Woods led the Buckeye scoring effort with 16 points in the contest. He finishes with 34 points in the BTT. Woods entered the game with a total of six points against the Spartans.
- Woods finished 4-of-4 from the foul line, grabbed one board and dished one assist against the Spartans.

C.J. JACKSON

- With eight points in the contest, C.J. Jackson is just four points shy of becoming the 58th 1,000-point scorer in program history.
- Jackson was 2-for-8 from 3-point range against the Spartans, extending his made 3-pointer streak to 25 of the last 26 games and in all but three games this season. He is now eighth among all-time leading 3-point scorers in Buckeye history with 148 makes in his career.

- Jackson led the team with five assists in the contest and added three boards and two steals.
- Jackson finishes his BTT career with 42 points and 22 assists.

ANDRE WESSON

- Andre Wesson scored a career BTT-high 14 points in the contest.
- Wesson made four 3-point field goals to tie his season high (last vs. Purdue 1/23/19).
- Wesson added three assists and rebounds for Ohio State.
