

POSTGAME NOTES

Houston 74 (33-3), Ohio State 59 (20-15)

March 24, 2019

BOK Center – Tulsa, Okla.

GAME/SERIES

- Ohio State is now 3-3 when playing in the state of Oklahoma and 2-2 in Tulsa.
- The Buckeyes fall to 4-1 against the Cougars in the all-time series.
- Ohio State is now 26-15 all-time against teams in the American Athletic Conference.

NCAA TOURNAMENT

- Ohio State's record in the NCAA Tournament is now 51-28.
- The Buckeyes are now 6-5 in the Midwest Region of the tournament.
- Ohio State is now 1-1 as a No. 11 seed in the NCAA Tournament.

TEAM

- Ohio State outshot Houston from 3-point range, finishing 34.5% (10-29) from beyond the arc while the Cougars shot 26.3% (5-19).
- Seniors C.J. Jackson and Joey Lane and graduate Keyshawn Woods all played their final game in the Scarlet and Gray.
- The Buckeyes' 10 made 3-pointers tied for fifth-most in Ohio State NCAA Tournament history and the 29 attempts are the second-most.

CHRIS HOLTMANN

- Chris Holtmann is now 6-5 in the NCAA tournament as a head coach.
- Holtmann is 45-24 through two seasons as the head coach of the Buckeyes.

C.J. JACKSON

- C.J. Jackson became the 58th 1,000-point scorer in Buckeye basketball history with 18 points in the game. In his 100-game Ohio State basketball career, Jackson finishes with 1,016 total points. He now ranks 55th among all-time leading scorers in program history.
- Jackson tied his season high of four 3-pointers on a career-high 11 attempts against the Cougars. He finishes his career with 152 made 3-point field goals, the eighth-most in program history. Jackson's 11 attempts is tied for second in Buckeye NCAA Tournament records.
- Jackson's Ohio State career finishes with 346 rebounds, 342 assists, 102 steals and 13 blocks.

KEYSHAWN WOODS

- Keyshawn Woods finished with 10 points in the contest to bring his career total points to 1,299 and 283 points as a Buckeye.
- Woods finishes his collegiate career with 391 rebounds, 294 assists, 80 steals and eight blocks.

JOEY LANE

- Joey Lane finishes his Buckeye career with 33 points, 12 rebounds, eight assists and four steals in 36 games played.

KALEB WESSON

- Kaleb Wesson's 15 points in the contest push him past the 800-point mark for his career. The sophomore finishes the season with 468 points and 806 for his career.
- Wesson grabbed six boards and one steal for Ohio State against Houston.
