

POSTGAME NOTES

Northwestern 68 (13-17, 4-15 B1G), Ohio State 50 (18-12, 8-11 B1G)

GAME/SERIES

- Ohio State is now 119-47 against Northwestern in the all-time series and 49-21 when playing in Evanston.

TEAM

- The Buckeyes fall to 105-110 all-time when playing in the state of Illinois and 2-1 in the state this season.
- The Buckeyes outrebounded the Wildcats, 45-39. The 45 boards tie the team's season high achieved for the first time this year at Nebraska (1/26/19).
- Both the Ohio State and Northwestern benches contributed 20 points in the contest.

CHRIS HOLTMANN

- Chris Holtmann falls to 4-1 when coaching against Northwestern.
- Holtmann is 27-22 against conference opponents as a head coach.

KEYSHAWN WOODS

- Keyshawn Woods led the Buckeyes with 15 points in the contest, his second time this season leading the team in points scored and eighth scoring in double-figures.
- Woods grabbed a season-high seven boards in the contest.

DUANE WASHINGTON JR.

- Duane Washington Jr. tied his career-best six rebounds against the Wildcats. All six were defensive rebounds, a career-high mark for the freshman.
- Washington scored 11 points, dished one helper and grabbed one steal for Ohio State.

KYLE YOUNG

- Kyle Young recorded two blocks in the contest, tying his career best for the fourth time (last at Indiana, 2/10/19).
- Young has made 33 of his last 44 field goal attempts (.750) in the last 13 games in which he has appeared.
- Young added seven points, four rebounds, two assists and one steal for the Buckeyes.
