Welcome to Ohio State University. I hope to make your visit to the Columbus area as trouble free as possible. The following is information and a list of services that will be provided to you and your team upon your arrival.

- The visiting athletic training room is a separate room that is located next to the visiting locker room. You will be provided: (2) ten gallon coolers, ice chest, ice bags, plastic wrap, hydrocollator, fridge, exercise bike, treatment table, taping table, and one case of bottled Gatorade for each game played.
- During scheduled practices, there will be a water cooler and towels on the visiting bench.
- During games, there will be a water cooler, towels, and injury ice on the visiting bench.
- As the host athletic trainer, I will provide water bottles for the goalies as well as water bottles and towels for both penalty boxes. I do ask each that each visiting team to provide their own water bottles for use on the bench during games. During intermission, my staff and I would be more than happy to fill your water bottles.
- During games and practices at the Schottenstien Center, all emergency equipment will be located behind the home team bench. This includes: spineboard, crutches, splint bag, oxygen, and an AED. Please note that the closest AED to the visiting locker room is located in the security office near the loading dock.
- During games, there will be a primary care sports medicine physician and an orthopedic physician onsite. We will also have an EMS squad on-site that is dedicated the ice surface.
- For emergencies or diagnostic care, The Ohio State Wexner Medical Center is located about one mile the Jerome Schottenstein Center. For further visiting team information, please visit our website at <http://www.ohiostatebuckeyes.com/ath-training/visiting-team-guide.html>.
