

BUCKS GO PRO 2.0 *Summer 2019*

Supervisor Feedback on Participants

- 100% of employers indicated that the student-athlete they worked with represented The Ohio State University well
- 100% of employers agreed or strongly agreed that the student-athlete they worked with knew how to communicate professionally
- Employers indicated that the Bucks Go Pro 2.0 interns had greater work ethic, discipline, commitment, respect, and humility than other interns of the same age
- Supervisors stated that the student-athletes they interviewed were slightly behind other interns of the same age with regard to experience and interview preparedness
- The strongest opportunity for growth identified by employers was the career readiness of the student-athletes, leading to an increase in the number of internship opportunities available through the Eugene D. Smith Leadership Institute.

Future Years

- 77% of supervisors said they would be interested in hosting two interns the following year
- 93% of companies indicated that they would like to participate again the following year
- 100% of the organizations agreed or strongly agreed that the Bucks Go Pro 2.0 program was a beneficial experience for their company
