

POSTGAME NOTES

No. 10 Ohio State 86 (4-0), Stetson 51 (2-2)

Nov. 18, 2019

TEAM

- Ohio State had three players in double figures: Kyle Young (15), Kaleb Wesson (13) and D.J. Carton (10).
- The last time an opponent scored 15 or fewer points before half was 15 at Rutgers (1/14/18). Stetson was held to 14 at the half.
- With Ibrahima Diallo's first bucket, three of Ohio State's freshmen this season have made their first field goal attempts, Carton a two vs. Cincinnati, Gaffney a three vs. UMass Lowell and Diallo a two vs. Stetson.
- The last 40-point lead in a game was against Purdue Fort Wayne (11/11/18) with a 46-point lead and a final score of 107-61.
- All available players saw game action.
- The last time the OSU bench scored more than 40 points was 43 against Indiana on 3/14/19. Buckeye players scored 41 points off the bench against Stetson.
- The last time Ohio State had a 20-point lead at half was 43-21 (+22) against South Carolina State (11/18/18). Buckeyes led Stetson 42-14 (+26) at the half.
- Ohio State led the entire game.

CHRIS HOLTSMANN

- This is Chris Holtmann's first game against Stetson. His record is now 1-0.

ANDRE WESSON

- Wesson had six points in his first game back since being injured.

KYLE YOUNG

- Posted a double-double with 15 points and 10 rebounds, his second of the season and for his career.

KALEB WESSON

- Wesson put up 13 points, tying his season high.

IBRAHIMA DIALLO

- Scored his first points on his first field goal attempt. Diallo ended the game with six points.
- Pulled down a season-high five rebounds.

E.J. LIDDELL

- Liddell's eight points and five rebounds tied his previous season highs from the game against Villanova (11/13/19).

HARRISON HOOKFIN

- Hookfin scored his first career points with two in a career-high six minutes he played.
