



# FENCING

The Ohio State fencing squad continued its dominance in 2011 as the team extended its streak of Top 5 finishes at the NCAA championships to 10 seasons with a fifth-place finish under the direction of 13th-year head coach Vladimir Nazlymov. Four Buckeyes were named All-Americans in the process, including freshman Katarzyna Dabrowa, sophomore Marco Canevari and juniors Margarita Tschomakova and Igor Tolkachev.

The Scarlet and Gray opened the season with a flawless 6-0 performance against varsity competition at the OSU Duals before traveling to New York for a pair of competitions. Ohio State finished with a 9-3 record at the New York University Invitational Jan. 22, including a 5-1 mark from the women, before battling to a 3-7 finish the following day against some of the top-ranked teams in the nation at the St. John's Invitational. The team closed out the regular season with a combined 12-0 performance at the Northwestern Duals Feb. 5-6. The Buckeye women notched a pair of 14-13 wins against Princeton and Temple and an 18-9 victory over the hosting Wildcats at the event.

Following a title-winning performance from the OSU men's epee squad of Tolkachev, Canevari and Kristian Boyadzhiev at the 2011 U.S. Collegiate Squad Championships Feb. 27, four Buckeyes earned gold medals in individual competition at the Midwest Fencing Conference Championships, including a sweep of men's events. Zain Shaito, Daniel Tafoya and Rhys Douglas proved to be the best in men's foil, epee and sabre, while Tschomakova earned first place in women's sabre. However, the hosting Notre Dame Fighting Irish again submitted an impressive performance in team competition, besting the Buckeyes by 100 points or fewer for the second consecutive year.

Ohio State then qualified the maximum 12 fencers for the 2011 NCAA Championships, highlighted by first-place finishes in regional qualifying by Canevari and Dabrowa. Serving as hosts for the competition, the Buckeyes turned in a brilliant performance in men's epee, which picked up 30 points for the team. Canevari tied for third with 16 wins while Tolkachev notched another 14 in a fifth-place performance. Shaito and Samuel Hardwicke-Brown earned 17 points combined in men's foil competition, while Rhys Douglas and Michael Douville added 18 in men's sabre.

In the women's competition, Dabrowa and classmate Caroline Piasecka totaled 30 points, second to only Notre Dame's 31 in women's epee. Dabrowa punched her ticket to the event's final four with 19 wins in pool play, but couldn't knock off eventual champion Courtney Hurley of Notre Dame in the semifinal bout. Tschomakova missed the final four of women's sabre by a single win after posting 16 victories in pool play. The junior combined with Alison Miller to claim 26 victories for the Buckeyes in sabre. Four-time NCAA participant Oksana Dmytruk capped her collegiate career with 13 victories in women's foil, one short of teammate Allison Henvick's mark of 14 wins.
