

# FENCING

The Ohio State fencing team captured its third combined (men's and women's) NCAA Championship in 2012, dominating the field at French Field House and St. John Arena March 22-25 in Columbus, Ohio. Zain Shaito, the Ohio State Male Athlete of the Year, and Katarzyna Dabrowa each won gold in their respective weapons, marking the first pair of individual titles for Ohio State since the 2006 campaign. In all, six Buckeyes earned first-team All-America status by finishing in the top 4 on each weapon. All three combined national titles have come under head coach Vladimir Nazlymov, who has led the Buckeyes for the last 13 seasons. Ohio State won its first title in 1942 when the NCAA supported only men's fencing.
