What is Bucks Go Pro 2.0?

The Bucks Go Pro 2.0 internship program is a summer internship program exclusively for Ohio State student-athletes. The internships are offered at various organizations and corporations in Ohio and provide real world experiences for student-athletes.

Who participates in the Bucks Go Pro 2.0 program?

The program is exclusively for Ohio State's student-athletes.

What is the structure of the program?

The interns are able to start working as early as May 4th, and could work for their respective organization as late as July 31st. The program dates are flexible in order to best accommodate the schedules of the supervisors and student-athletes, while aligning with the start dates of other interns working within the organizations. Interns will work 240 hours over the course of their internship. The daily responsibilities of the internship are decided by the organization. We expect the opportunities to help enhance the intern's professional development and personal growth.

Interns attend a networking event where they are given the opportunity to engage with local employers and professionals in efforts to enhance their networking skills. The event is held in conjunction with the Bucks Go Pro 1.0 program, allowing the interns to network with other student-athletes and athletics staff, as well.
