HEALTH AND SAFETY

Whether you've visited Ohio State before or it's your first time, we want to make sure that you feel confident in our commitment to your well-being. We are taking steps to keep our visitors safe and healthy — and we can all make a difference for each other. The information and resources below will not only help keep you safe but will also help you ensure the health and safety of others.



Physical Distancing

- Six Feet of physical distancing should be maintained except during athletic activity under staff supervision.
- Campers will be placed in to small groups or cohorts.



Mask requirements

- Fully vaccinated people do not need to wear masks indoors or outdoors, in accordance with public health guidelines and university guidelines.
- Individuals who are not vaccinated are required to continue wearing masks indoors.



Cleaning & Disinfecting

- High touch surfaces will be cleaned regularly throughout the day.
- Staff and participants are expected to follow hand washing protocol.



Food and Beverage

- Food service will primarily be served individually in boxed and grab and go style.
- Pre-package only or refueling (bars).
- Water will be available on site.



Contact Tracing

- Participants displaying symptoms of Covid-19 will be isolated to a quarantine space. Parents or guardians must arrange for immediate pickup of their camper.
- Participants must report to Buckeye Sports Camp Administration any positive Covid-19 test results if received within three days of the camp.



Daily Health Checks

- All campers and staff are required to submit a daily assessment of symptoms along with a temperature check onsite.
- Campers must have a reading of 99.9 or lower. If a camper registers higher than 99.9, they will be re-screened 10 minutes later. If the reading remains 99.9 or higher, the camper will be sent home and a refund for the day will be issued.

The Ohio State University venues continue to work in partnership and follow all guidelines and protocols set by the university, state of Ohio, and CDC to ensure a safe and healthy buckeye experience. Your continued flexibility, cooperation and commitment are vital to keeping the community safe. Buckeye Sports Camp Administration will be monitoring compliance with all applicable safety protocols. Failure to follow safety protocols may include, up to, removal from camp.
