Hello, campers and parents!

We look forward to having you join us at the Swim Breaststroke Clinic! Below are some important reminders before you come to campus.

Parent Consent and Concussion Form: The Parent Consent, Waiver & Release Form AND the Concussion Information Form are **REQUIRED** for all participants. These forms must be completed during online registrations. Athletes will not be permitted to participate without these forms.

**** If you completed online registration and/or signed both medical forms online, you do not need to bring another set to check-in. ****

Check-in: Check-in for the Swim Freestyle Clinic will be from **11:30am – Noon on Sunday, May 8.** Participants will check-in at the main entrance of McCorkle Aquatic Pavilion.

Camp Schedule: Instruction will be from Noon – 2:30pm.

Parking: We recommend parking at the Tuttle Garage north of the facility. Address: 2025 Tuttle Park Pl, Columbus Oh. 43210

What to Bring: Participants are required to bring all necessary equipment needed for participating, i.e goggles, towels, swimsuit, etc.

Spectators: Will be allowed on site.

Mask Guidelines: Masks will be optional in most indoor spaces on The Ohio State University campuses. In settings where masks are optional, students, faculty, staff and visitors can decide on an individual basis whether or not they will continue to wear a mask. Individuals should stay home if they are feeling sick and follow CDC guidelines if they test positive for COVID-19 or are exposed to someone with the virus.
